### AFTERCARE PROGRAM FEES

Students not registered in the Full-Time Aftercare Program will incur a charge of \$20 per day, per child.  
This fee will be added to the following month's tuition ACH withdrawal.

**Inclusions & Exclusions:** Tuition covers books, technology, ACSI membership, and insurance fees. It does not cover high school online honors courses, student supplies, field trips, extracurricular activities, after-school care, or uniforms.

High school students who choose to enroll in an **additional** online course approved by administration through our partnership with **Sevenstar Academy** will be subject to the following **additional** fees: **\$675** per 1.0 credit course and **\$535** per 0.5 credit course. This fee will be added to the monthly tuition ACH withdrawal.

**Multi-Sibling Discount:** A **ONE-TIME \$1,200 discount per family** will be applied to the annual tuition for families enrolling three or more siblings for the first time. This discount is available only to multi-sibling families who are paying the full tuition amount without any scholarship assistance.

**Financial Assistance:** Families can apply for a tuition scholarship online at [www.wcajesup.org](http://www.wcajesup.org) under the "Admissions" tab. To be considered, families must complete the financial aid application within 30 days of enrollment.
